

Hayes Township Refuse and Bulk Collection Guidelines

Bulk Items	White Goods	Electronic Waste
<p>Acceptable: Standard bulk items include (but are not limited to):</p> <p>Bed frames / Box springs / mattresses</p> <p>Cardboard must be flattened and bundled not exceeding 4' x 4' not exceeding 50 lbs.</p> <p>Carpet and padding are acceptable but must be rolled and tied with tape or string into 4' sections no heavier than 40 lbs. (4 bundles equals one bulk item).</p> <p>Furniture</p> <p>Grills – Gas grills must have the propane tank removed prior to disposal.</p> <p>Hot Tubs must be cut into sections under 4' and less than 100 lbs. prior to disposal.</p> <p>Lawn mowers – Push lawn mowers must be drained of oil and / or gas prior to disposal. <i>[Riding lawn mowers are not acceptable.]</i></p> <p>Paint cans – Paint must be solidified before pickup. Please put kitty litter or sand inside wet paint cans to solidify. Throw lid in trash. Once paint is solid, place paint containers at the curb for collection.</p> <p>Pianos must be cut into sections under four feet and less than 100 lbs. prior to disposal.</p> <p>Storm doors and windows must have glass broken out of the frame and placed in a hard container or small box, taped well, and marked “Broken Glass”. <i>[Large amounts may require an extra fee.]</i></p> <p>Swing sets</p>	<p>Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Washers • Dryers • Hot Water Tanks • Dishwashers • Dehumidifiers • Stoves • Freon-based appliances with Freon removed <div style="border: 1px solid black; background-color: #e6f2ff; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Freon-based units must have the Freon removed and tagged by a licensed heating and cooling technician prior to pick up.</p> </div>	<p>Acceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Televisions • Stereos • Microwaves • Computer monitors, Desktop PCs, and printers <i>[maximum of 1 complete unit per pickup]</i> <p>Note: small, lightweight electronic items, such as radios, alarm clocks, coffee pots, toasters and toaster ovens, can openers, <i>etc.</i>, should be bagged with regular trash. These items will be taken at no additional charge.</p>
<p>Unacceptable: Products (and <i>similar items</i>) such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • insecticides • liquids, such as oil, gasoline, antifreeze, wet paint • car batteries • propane tanks • yard waste, sod, tree stumps • roofing shingles, siding • engine blocks, auto body parts • dirt, gravel, stones, rocks, concrete, cement (even if attached to something), cement blocks, bricks • hazardous waste 	<div style="border: 1px solid black; background-color: #e6f2ff; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 10px;"> <p>TIRES – whole tires are not acceptable to collect as trash in Michigan landfills effective November 1, 2004, under Michigan Public Act 34.</p> </div> <p>Unacceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Commercial-sized appliances • Freon-based appliances with Freon still in them 	<p>Unacceptable:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Commercial-sized electronics
<p>Items deemed dangerous to personnel or equipment (gasoline, hot ashes, items too heavy to be lifted by two average people) will not be picked up.</p> <p>Waste Management will not collect or dispose of prohibited items. Disposal of prohibited items are your responsibility.</p>		



Rubbish Collection

Weekly.

Monday, 6 am-8 pm — **EAST SIDE OF U.S. 127**

Tuesday, 6 am-8 pm — **WEST SIDE OF U.S. 127**

Have your items out to the road by 6:00 am, or the evening prior (in a covered container).

Large Items:

Furniture and other non-metal household furnishings will be collected each week along with the solid waste. Residents are not required to call our office prior to the scheduled pick-up days.

Metal Items:

Metal items will be collected each week along with the solid waste. Residents must call Waste Management at 1 (989) 539-9626 or 1 (800) 323-9626 before 5:00 PM on the Wednesday preceding the pick-up date and provide their address and items to be collected.

NOTE: Appliances containing or once containing HFC or CFC (Freon) will not be collected unless the refrigerant has been extracted and tagged by a certified and licensed extractor.

Prohibited Items:

Items deemed dangerous to personnel or equipment (gasoline, hot ashes, items too heavy to be lifted by two average people) will not be picked up.

Waste Management **will not** collect or dispose of prohibited items (See reverse side for a list of unacceptable items). Disposal of prohibited items is your responsibility.

Holiday schedule

When the pickup date falls on an observed holiday, pickup will be on the next business day.

Waste Management Winter Weather Reminder

The following weather-related conditions may affect your collection:

- Snow / ice too deep to push container to truck
- Steep hill or winding road that may be difficult to navigate during snow or ice conditions
- No place to turn around due to areas not being plowed
- Road closures
- Wind chill factor which impacts the safety of our drivers and proper vehicle operation
- Reduced visibility such as blizzard conditions, sleet, fog, and hail

Yard Waste Collection

Yard waste is collected on certain Wednesdays (6 am-8 pm), April 1-November 15; See the Yard Waste Pickup Calendar for specific dates.

Have your items out to the road by 6:00 am, or the evening prior (in a covered container).

Hayes Township Yard-Waste Preparation Guidelines

Place leaves in reusable 30-gallon containers marked "Yard Waste", or in 30-gallon biodegradable paper bags. *No Plastic Bags will be picked up.*

Cut brush, hedge trimmings, and small limbs into 4' sections and securely bundle. Bundles must be no more than 4' long and weigh no more than 50 lbs.

Holiday schedule

When the pickup date falls on an observed holiday, pickup will be on Thursday.

When an observed holiday falls on Monday or Tuesday, regular rubbish pickup is delayed one day; Yard Waste Collection moves to Thursday that week.
